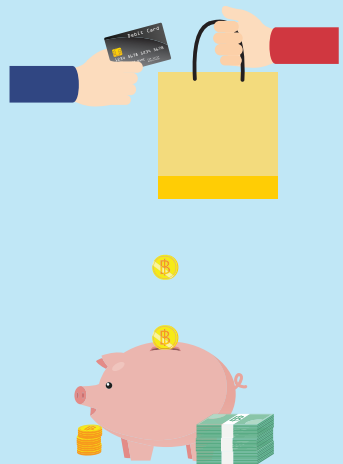


Electronic card usage expansion project

The government has a policy to support merchants and state agencies across the country to install Electronic Data Capture (EDC) machines to provide people with more convenient payment options.



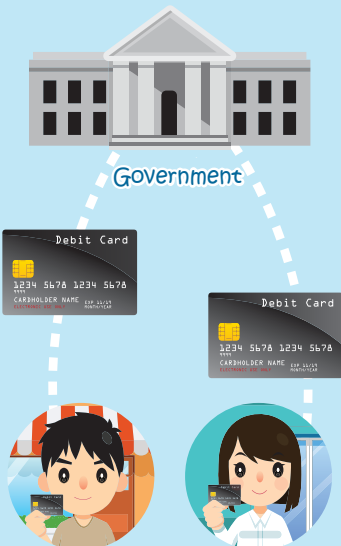
People can make payments for products and services at merchants using a debit card instead of cash to enjoy lower fees.

What is a debit card?



A debit card is an electronic card used for cash withdrawals, money transfers, ATM transactions or payments for products or services at shops through EDC machines or other online platforms. When a debit card is used, the transaction amount is instantly deducted from the user's bank account. Individual that holds a bank account is eligible to apply for a debit card.

Do you hold a debit card?

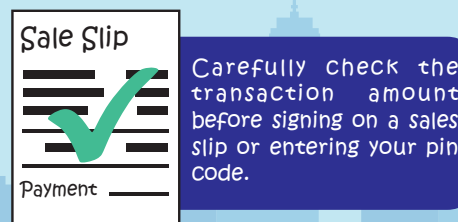
You can easily notice that a debit card bears a 3-digit number on the back of the card and the logo of the debit card brand on the front of the card.
